

## WONDERING ABOUT RUNNING START?

Discuss pros/cons with family- classes are challenging, count for college credit, start a college transcript, are tuition free (books and fees can still be a cost) etc.

Make a copy and fill out our Running Start Advising tool and have it signed by guardian. Bring to your advising appointment with Susie  W Running Start Advising Tool Cedar 21-22.docx
Follow procedures for entrance at the school of your choice
Bring passing accuplacer scores and your advising tool (above) to a Cedar counseling appointment for course recommendations.
Look through the course offerings and compare that with your schedule (both academic and personal). Think about which courses you want to take. Search College Courses Here
Fill out RSEV form and bring to Susie HW at Cedar Attachment B - RSEVF
Schedule advising appointment with the college of your choice to register for college classes.
Attend College orientation and arrange for books/logins etc.
Be sure we have an updated copy of your RSEV form, have updated your Cedar schedule, and let us know how it's going.
Stay in touch with your advisor. Just because you are in college doesn't mean we don't want to support you academically and personally. Please attend check ins when possible
