# Project Based Learning


- Project based learning is a form of learning where you have a combination of 2 subject like math and science or P.E and Web design
- This gives a better understanding in real world situations and help relate the real world to the classroom.
- This also give opportunity for students to collaborate with each other and also learn how to work independently. (attendance is vital)
- ☐ This can also be used to create real world solutions to problems
- Project based learning can also help students create not only a problem solving way with others but also friendship and community

## What earning credit looks like

- At Cedar High School you will earn 1.0 credits for each class when classes are combined
- Students will be taught through teacher designed projects and not just out of a textbook or using standard curriculum
- If a student completes all of their projects/courses in a year, you could earn 7.5 credits per year
- Students may also earn additional credits through Fuel Ed courses, Running Start, or other community partnerships
